New features

Leveraging the audiological expertise of Phonak as well as artificial intelligence, Naída Paradise introduces a range of new features:

Speech Enhancer

Understanding someone who is speaking softly or speaking from a distance in a quiet environment is often a challenge for persons with more severe hearing loss. This feature is designed to help you hear soft speech in quiet situations.*

Dynamic Noise Cancellation

Hearing in noisy situations is a challenge. This feature improves signal-to-noise ratio and can be adjusted to personal preference using the myPhonak app.*

Motion Sensor Hearing

Having a conversation with someone especially while walking can be difficult. When in a noisy environment, such as a busy street, it becomes even more challenging. Naída P-PR is equipped with a new motion sensor that can detect if you are moving. Motion Sensor Hearing leads to a better speech understanding and a better overall listening experience while on the go.^{1*}

- * Final levels of speech understanding are influenced by several factors, including:
 - The level of residual peripheral and central auditory function.
 - The correct use of an appropriate level of hearing instrument technology. Four technology levels are available: 90, 70, 50 & 30. Your hearing care professional will discuss the most appropriate level of technology to meet your hearing needs.
 - The use of hearing instruments accurately fitted by your hearing aid professional.

Connects to smartphones, TV and more

Universal connectivity means that Naída Paradise connects to your iOS®, Android™, or other Bluetooth®-enabled devices* so you can stream audio directly to your hearing aids.

Hands-free calls let you answer or reject calls with the simple push of the multi-function button, even if your phone is across the room. When you speak, the hearing aids detect your voice and send it back to the phone.

Multiple Bluetooth connections offer you a seamless listening experience for example when listening to music and then switching to an incoming call. Up to eight Bluetooth-enabled devices can be paired and you can easily alternate between two simultaneously connected devices.

Tap Control is enabled through the motion sensor in Naída P-PR. You can accept phone calls, hang up, and even switch between devices – simply by double tapping your ear. You can also play or pause music, stop or resume streaming as well as activate Bluetooth-based voice assistant apps.

Empowering smart apps

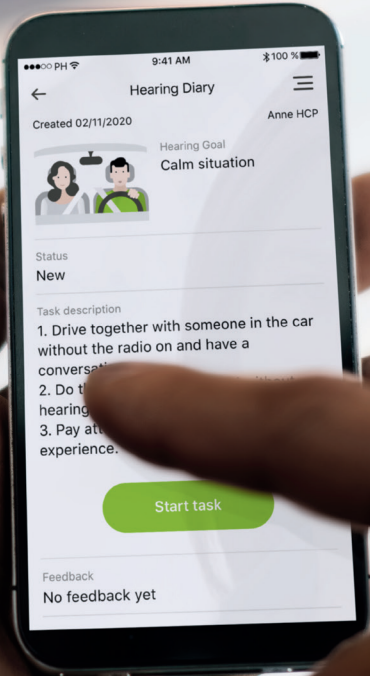
It's not just another app – it's the smart way to control your hearing aids, access useful features, and personalise your settings. Download the **myPhonak app** (App Store or Google Play) and get the most out of your hearing aids.

Remote Control allows you to adjust and control your sound settings on the go. You can also switch between programs or create custom programs for specific listening situations. Thanks to **myPhonak Memory**,* the last used custom program can now be saved to the hearing aid and accessed using the multi-function button.

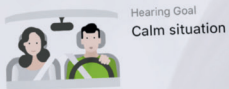
Remote Support allows your hearing care professional to adjust your hearing aids remotely in real-time. This is helpful in situations where you cannot make it for a personal consultation or when you want to optimise your hearing aid settings in real-life situations.

Finally, the myPhonak app helps you keep track of your hearing experience. It shows usage information and indicates battery level. You can also manage pairings with other devices and configure Bluetooth phone calls and the Tap Control feature.

Another example is when the speaker is wearing a face mask and you do not have the additional support from lip reading. This is where **Roger technology** can help.

Roger remote microphones from Phonak help you understand more speech in noise and over distance.² They can stream directly to Naída Paradise hearing aids without the need for attaching or wearing external receivers.* If the surrounding noise level increases, Roger adapts accordingly, keeping the speaker's voice above the background noise.

For many people with hearing loss, the combination of hearing aids and Roger helps them to lead socially active and professionally fulfilling lives.

* RogerDirect™ requires the installation of Roger receivers into the Phonak hearing aids, by means of a Roger X receiver or a Roger iN microphone.
